Your responsibilities will include:

- Team leadership and project management of new CVE intervention projects, including ensuring delivery within agreed timeframes and budgets.

- Identification and management of critical project risks.
- Leading a small to a medium-sized project team.
- Overseeing analysis of diverse forms of data, including social media metrics, violent extremist material and data gathered by our in-house specialist software.
- Sharing and developing subject matter expertise across the organisation, whether based on violent extremist movements, regional knowledge, professional or academic background.
- Developing new methodologies to track and challenge violent extremism.
- Supporting our business development by identifying and applying for funding opportunities, building relationships with clients and partner organisations.

Requirements:

- Demonstrable ability to work under pressure, taking action and getting things done, both in managing your own workload and that of others.
- Excellent written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
